THINGS YOU SHOULD DO

Stop immediately, clear of traffic if possible.

Turn off ignition.

Leave lights or signals on if practical and safe!

Establish driver of other vehicle immediately.

Warn oncoming traffic (flares or flagging)

Notify police — ask them to call ambulance, etc.

Take photos if possible.

List information in this booklet.

Retrieve licence, registration and insurance proof of other driver.

Notify your insurance agent promptly.

THINGS YOU SHOULD NOT DO

DO NOT Smoke if danger of fire.

DO NOT Get involved in an argument.

DO NOT Admit any responsibility.

DO NOT Sign anything except for Police.

DO NOT Disclaim injury before seeing a Doctor.

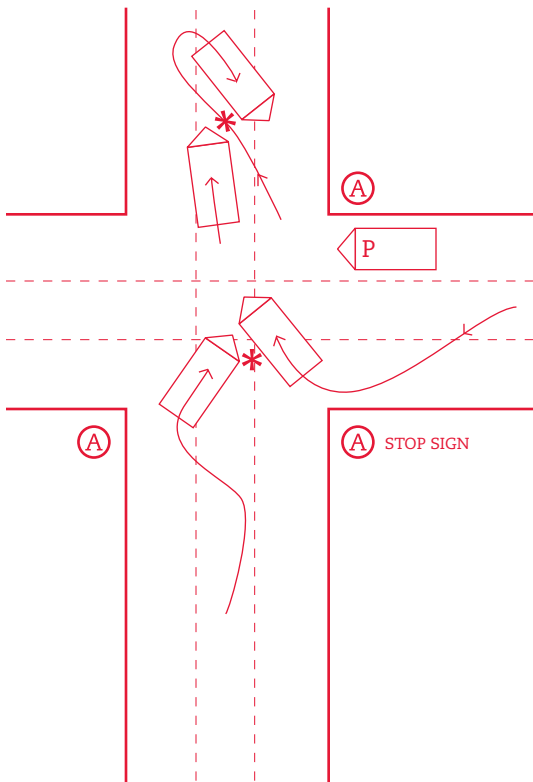

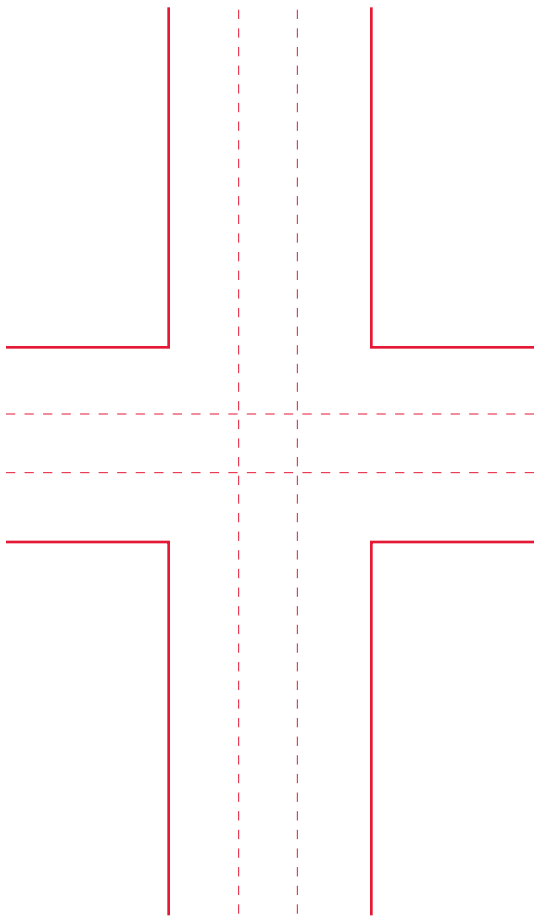
